Volunteer Opportunities

The Hangar would not be successful without our volunteers who give their time each and every week to the ministry. Whether you are in college, a parent of a student in the Hangar, or an adult with no teenage students, we have a place for you in the Hangar! We have different positions of varying capacities and commitments. The volunteer positions we have in student ministry are:

SMALL GROUP LEADER

Small group leaders in the Hangar do life with our students. Every week they attend the youth service with their small group and then immediately afterward lead a small group time with their group. We currently have 25 small groups in the Hangar ranging from 7th grade to 12th grade. Every small group has 2-3 adult leaders who pour into their group of students each and every week. We also encourage leaders to spend time with some of their students outside of Sunday nights.

Between May & August we recruit leaders for the upcoming school year. It is a long recruitment process but it's well worth it! We ask leaders we recruit to at least commit through the upcoming school year so our groups have consistent leadership throughout the school year. Leaders can then choose to come back for the next year with their same students but one grade older. We will sometimes have leaders who lead the same group for 6 years! (7th-12th grade). Small group leading in the Hangar is a big commitment and it isn't easy, but so incredibly fulfilling!

TECH (LIGHTING, VISUAL & AUDIO)
